- Terms of the sale are cash and payment in full, must be paid immediately after the sale. A cheque is acceptable from properly identified individuals. Pay the sales staff in all cases. On final payment for a horse, the cashier will issue a receipt of which must be presented to the barn manager for the release of the horse from barn. Buyers do not lose these receipts!
- **ATTENTION U.S. BUYER!** We recommend all sale animals be coggins tested prior to sale time. However, any animal purchased at the sale will require a valid coggins test to cross the border. Arrangements can be made to have a certified veterinarian perform this test and have the health papers prepared for transport at the buyer's expense. The Canadian Draft Horse Futurity makes no claim as to which animals have or have not been tested prior to sale time. Each owner will provide this information for his or her respective animals.
- All horses are subject to 13% H.S.T. US Exchange rate will be announced at the beginning of the sale.

- All horses will be sold on the information in the footnotes, of which, were furnished by the consignor. The Sale/Futurity Staff and Auctioneer is neither responsible for any footnotes or for any warranties concerning the horse catalogue.
- The highest bidder will be the buyer. If a dispute arises between 2 or more bidders, the horse shall immediately be put up again for advance bids. If there is no advance, then the horse shall go to the person from whom the auctioneer recognized the last bid.
- **NO SALES: (this does not apply to weanling sales)** Commission of 5% of the last bid will be charged to consignors of “no sale” horses. This is to be paid the day of the sale.
- Unless otherwise announced at the time of the sale by the owner there is no guarantee or warranty of any kind as to the soundness or condition of any animal. THE BUYER has a responsibility to examine a horse carefully before they bid on it. If you buy a horse on impulse without inspecting it before you bid, you may expect to find some surprises. IN THAT CASE YOU STILL OWN THE HORSE! The seller and auctioneer are not responsible for you if you do not check out the horse before you buy. Once you bid on a horse you are indicating that you have checked it out enough to satisfy yourself and no one else is responsible.
- The signed registration papers for all horses selling as registered must be received by the secretary prior to the sale. The registration will be transferred to the Buyer at the Seller’s expense. The Buyer will receive the paper furnished by the Seller whether it is Canadian or American. The sales staff reserve the right to reject any horse brought to the sale for reasons such as, but not limited to, incomplete paperwork, unsoundness, or poor quality.
- **LIABILITY** – The sales staff and auctioneer are not responsible for any injuries to person(s) or animal(s) attending the sale. Everyone on the premises is cautioned to exercise reasonable care, and attendance at the sale shall be at his/her assumption of risk for damages or injuries to animal(s) or his/herself.
- The Canadian Draft Horse Futurity will be circulating a questionnaire following the futurity competition and auction. We hope that you will participate and provide feedback that may help continue and enhance the future of the futurity.
